CODE OF ETHICS FOR RESEARCH

This code of ethics for research has been developed to articulate the importance of integrity and rigour in all research and project work carried out at Narayanrao Kale Smruti Model College, Karanja (Gh.), College affiliated to Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur, University.

"Plagiarism" means an act of academic dishonesty and a breach of ethics. It involves using someone else's work as one's own. It also includes data plagiarism and self plagiarism.

• All students, researchers and faculties of Narayanrao Kale Smruti Model College, are expected to observe the highest standards of integrity, honesty and professionalism in respect of their own actions in any study, project, assignment, research work, thesis, dissertation, term papers, reports, publications or any other such documents undertaken by them.

• Students are expected to submit original work in the case of assignments, projects and dissertations.

• Plagiarism and passing of another's work as one's own is not permitted.

• Resorting to plagiarism and misrepresentation of involvement or authorship amount to a failure to adhere to meet ethical standards and integral practices. Such actions at the undergraduate and post-graduate levels would amount to downgrading of assignments, mandates to re-do and directions for resubmission.

• All research scholars, faculties are required to submit their thesis, research papers; projects, etc. for plagiarism check through URKUND plagiarism check software, made available to the university through the UGC/INFLIBNET, or other free plagiarism check software's.

- The undertaking shall include the fact that the document has been duly checked through a Plagiarism detection tool approved by the institute and submit report to college research committee
- Levels of Plagiarism in non-core areas
 For all other (non-core) cases, plagiarism would be quantified into following levels in ascending
 order of severity for the purpose of its definition:
 Similarities up to 10% excluded
 Level 1: Similarities above 10% to 40%
 Level 2: Similarities above 40% to 60%
 Level 3: Similarities above 60%
 If misconduct of code is happen the penalties will be given as per institution rules
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
